- 2. A current Marketplace farmer or artisan seeking improve their products and produce through increased education

To apply, you must also include:

- 1. Three (3) letters of recommendation from a guidance counselor, work supervisor, etc.
- 2. A separate stand alone 500-1000 word proposal to include:
 - a. Educational and/or work background
 - b. Reason for applying and the area of expertise sought
 - c. The need for the grant/scholarship
 - d. How the grant/scholarship will be put to use to benefit both you and the Marketplace community in the long term
 - e. How the grant/scholarship will be executed to include: cost, description of the class/program, etc.
 - f. Other sources of financial aid applied for and received
 - g. A course/apprenticeship summary paper upon completion outlining knowledge gained from the grant/scholarship
 - h. Commitment to bring resultant product/service knowledge gained to market within the Marketplace 50 mile radius
